- ✓ Learn to implement evidence-based academic, behavior, communication, and functional interventions at home
- ✓ Researchers will collect data on my behavior and my child's behavior
- ✓ Participate between 1 and 3 hours per week, for no more than 12 weeks

### Who can participate?

- ✓ Intellectual Disability, autism, Down syndrome, Angelman syndrome, Fragile X syndrome, Smith-Magenis syndrome, Fetal Alcohol Syndrome, Williams syndrome, Prader-Willi syndrome, or Rett syndrome
- ✓ Adolescents with a developmental disability between the ages of 10 and 22
- ✓ Parents must participate with their child as part of a parent-child dyad, and must be their child's legal guardian
